## "Roots & Rising – Washington Park" Food Drive We have delivered 884 lbs. so far in 2024 (We delivered a total of 4.493 lbs. in 2023)

239 lbs. of food and hygiene items were delivered on March 26 bringing this year's total to 884 lbs. They served 576 individuals from 231 households in the Community Food Center in March. Suggested items for May are:

hygiene items; breakfast items (cereal, pancake mix, and oatmeal); cooking oil; and flour and sugar. Other items are always welcome and will be utilized. Toilet paper is always needed.




"In the Garden"


